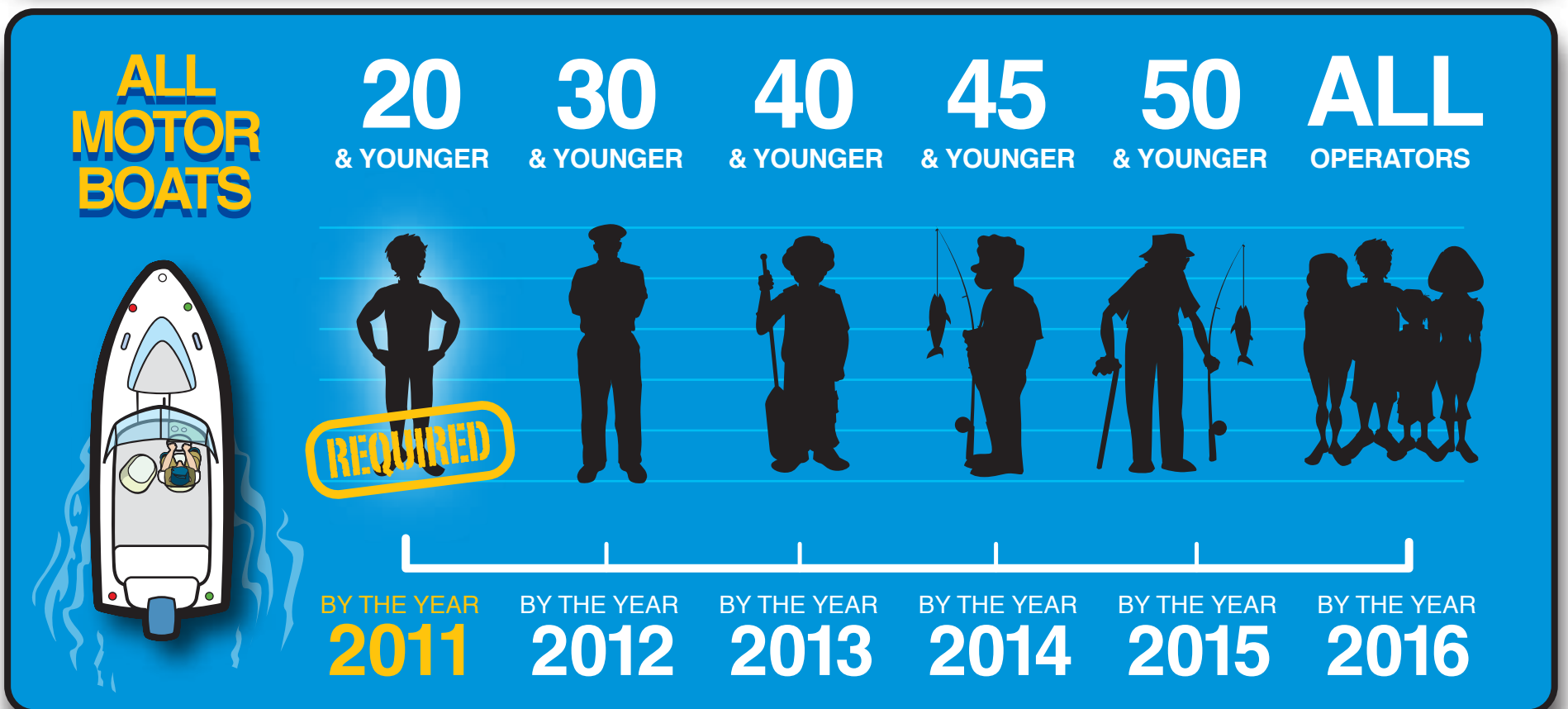
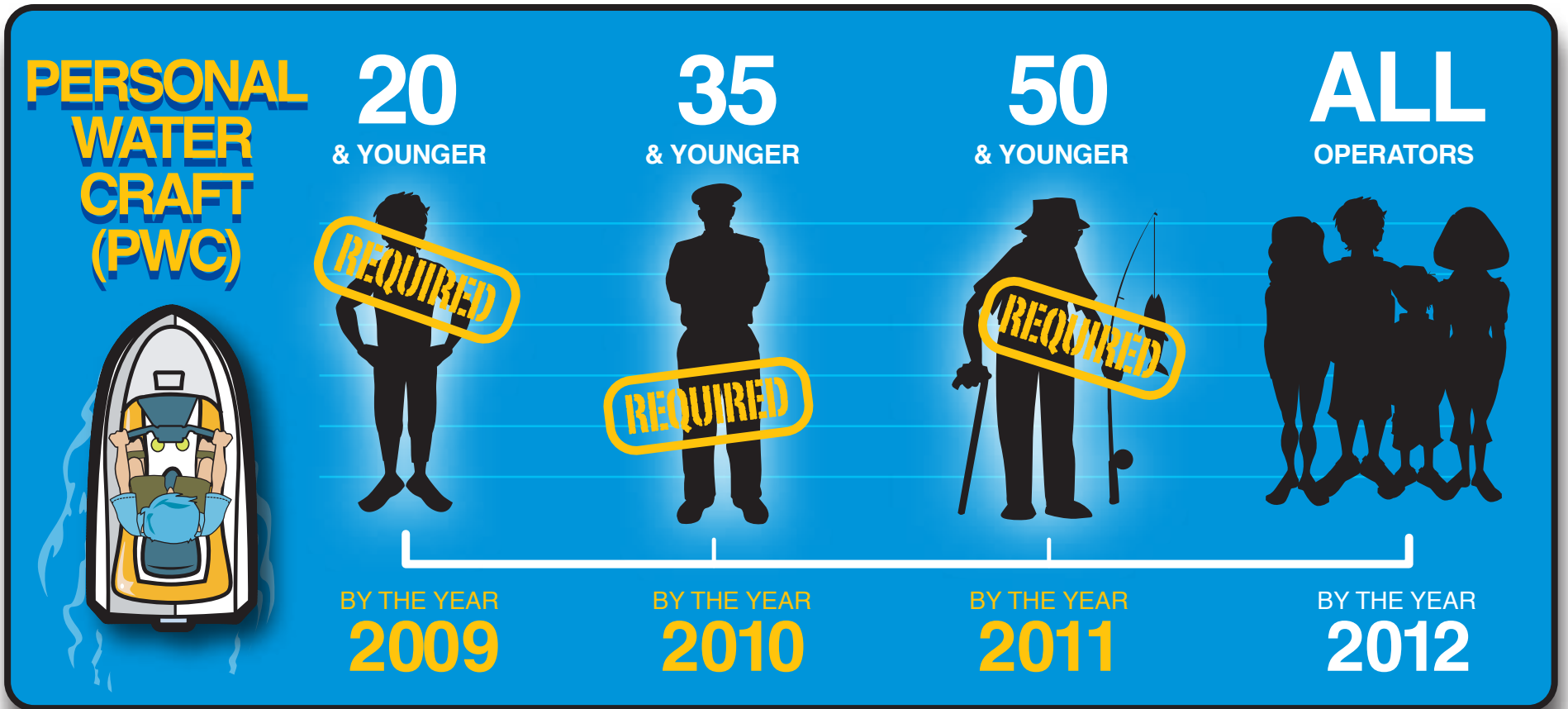


Did you know that since 2007 the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries has been phasing in mandatory boater education?

As of July 1st, personal watercraft operators 50 years of age and younger – as well as motorboat operators 20 years of age and younger – must carry proof of course completion onboard.



No one under the age of 13 may operate any personal watercraft (PWC) on Virginia State Waters



Children under the age of 13 must wear a properly fitted Personal Flotation Device (life jacket) when onboard any vessel that is underway unless they are below deck or in an enclosed cabin.
